HOUSING

When students register online, they will be able to apply for a student accommodation through UPEC university.

However, please note that we cannot reserve rooms for all exchanges students. We strongly recommend you to look from your side too.



Important

Finding accommodation in Paris takes a while and rents are expensive. We advise you to come 2 weeks before the beginning of the courses in order to be able to visit the rooms/flats.
